Our 2017 Winter Stamp & Postcard Show, January 20-21, is formatted and managed well by Mark Postmus. The show theme will be the 100th Anniversary of the U.S. Air Mail Service. CPS will feature a special montage of air mail philatelic material highlighted by a large poster board, 40" x 60", featuring an outline of state of S.C. surrounded by photoscans of famour air mail issues from "Jenny's To Jets" which is the theme title for honoring the anniversary. Included on the map (hopefully) will be covers from various airports around the state as "first flights" when the post office initiated air mail service from different airports within the state. The other project for the show will be air mail philatelic exhibits. One frame will feature 15 pages of First Day of Issue covers of air mail stamps, another will be perhaps 5 pages of air mail stamps along 10 pages of postal stationery, then a frame of 15 pages of special flight cachets with cancels used during National Air Mail Week held in 1938. If you have ANY of these items in your collection that you LOAN to CPS, please bring. On covers, print your last name in PENCIL on back of envelope. Make a list of stamps yopu are contributing. We will assemble the pages at the end of the meeting this Sunday, our regular monthly meeting. After the show, the frames will be disassembled, materials taken out and returned to owners. Photos will be taken of the exhibit. If you can stay and help mount the material Sunday afternoon, please do so. Your help will be needed and very much appreciated.

We will welcome back USPS personnel who will provide postal support for the show on Saturday, 20th, offering stamps for sale. Of course, the special pictorical cancellation, provided courtesy USPS, will be used to cancel covers. Thanks to our Postmaster, Walter Rowland, Kertina Epps and others providing supprt.
