We had a great turnout for the regular March meeting and a not-so-great turnout for the March fifth Thursday bourse. The March regular meeting revisited the issue of meeting format and a motion was made, seconded and approved to revise the fifth Thursday meeting format to be a presentation followed by a bourse. A list of presenters was started. Dick Jackson signed up to be the June 30th (next fifth Thursday meeting) presenter. We also discussed the Facebook page for the Holston Stamp Club and a show of hands indicated only 4 or 5 members used Facebook. Chris White could not attend so we rescheduled further Facebook discussion to a future meeting.

I am happy to say we acquired a new member, Jesse Mason, so please make him feel welcome and that brings our 2016 paid membership to 33. Those who have not paid need to pay the club treasurer or mail the attached form to Bob Smith at the address on the form.

The Knoxville Philatelic Society most graciously lent our club some exhibit frames for our use at HOLPEX 2016. During the March meeting Richard Jackson with some helpers held a show and tell demonstration with the frames. Richard showed us how to set up a frame and demonstrated how easy it is to mount your exhibit. We have enough frames for at least eight exhibits of up to 16 pages (8.5 inch by 11 inch portrait format) per exhibit. At this time we have five committed exhibits and are looking for three more. Please think about making a commitment to prepare and exhibit during our April meeting. Questions about layouts?—See Richard.

We also had a report from our Stamp Acquisition Committee about the items they bought for the club at the KnoxPEX auction. The committee bought two lots. One lot was three volumes of Souvenir sheets cataloging at \$2,798, which we will sell at 20% of catalog value to club members. The other lot was a worldwide album of 565 pages with basically pre-1940 issues (approximately 14,000 to 18,000 stamps), which we will sell at club auctions, country by country, starting at two cents per stamp.

Don Ashley 's "stumper" about the seven previous meeting places of our club was answered by Van VanNostrand, who added a few to the list of seven.

This was followed by our special auction that included 20 items from the two lots the club bought at KnoxPEX. Eleven

sellers sent 153 items home with new owners.

Stamp of the Month

For those club members who like to collect stamps that are about subjects that are truly out of this world as of Feb. 22

USPS issued a new stamp for you to add to your collection. It is the latest global forever stamp to be used to mail a one-ounce letter to any country to which First-Class Mail International service is available. The image on the stamp is Earth's moon. It is a bright, golden-yellow photograph surrounded by a blue frame. This self-adhesive stamp is sold in panes of 10 with an appropriate depiction of a forest at night below the 10 stamps.




