Changes to in-person meetings

- In 2024 meetings will be on the <u>second</u> Sunday of the Month at 3 PM. There are two reasons for this: 1) having Zoom meetings on the 4th Monday evening-- which will continue-- but in-person meetings on the 1st Sunday meant that two meetings of ASCC could occur within days of one another; and 2) meetings on the 1st Sunday of the month are more likely to fall on holiday weekends, when some members have other plans/travel. Thus, the change to *second* Sunday at 3:00 PM.
- **Meetings will now include a Show and Tell.** Members coming to in-person meetings are invited to bring in an item or group of items that would interest Club members. No one has to do this, but we (Club members) think it enlivens the meetings, as we all like fraternizing and exchanging information.
- Encouraging members to bring in material for sale. Recent in-person meetings have been short--yes, we all hang around and chat later--but only two people reliably bring in stuff to sell, and the auctions are over rapidly.
