


Postmark Atlanta Atlanta Stamp Collector's Club

U.S. Postal Service files for rate Increases

Requested to take effect on January 22, 2023 the 1 oz. letter rate will increase from 60 cents to 63 cents. Second ounce will be 24 cents. Post Cards will increase from 44 cents to 48 cents. First Class International 1 oz is now \$1.45 to all countries. Rates for 2nd and more ounces differ by country price group. A link to the full price list on the USPS site is below:
