Southeastern Stamp Expo 2024 Set for January 26-28

The officers of the Southeast Federation of Stamp Clubs are pleased to announce that the Southeastern Stamp Expo, an APS World Series of Philately (WSP) accredited national stamp show sponsored by the Southeast Federation of Stamp Clubs, will be held at the Hilton Hotel Atlanta Northeast, 5993 Peachtree Industrial Blvd., Peachtree Corners, GA 30092 on January 26 – 28.

The Hilton Atlanta Northeast has been the Expo's home since 2013. This business class hotel was recently renovated from top to bottom, and Exhibitors are offered an excellent accommodation rate of \$129 per night, which includes two buffet breakfasts each morning.

Show hours are Friday and Saturday 10 a.m.- 5:30 p.m., and Sunday 10 a.m. - 3 p.m. Parking is free. Admission to the Expo is \$5.00 for the entire family all weekend.

The Expo's theme is the centenary of the birth of former U.S. President and Nobel Peace Prize recipient Jimmy Carter. In keeping with the theme, show admission includes a free raffle ticket for the drawing of a Jimmy Carter autographed Presidential inauguration cover.

- Society meetings (open to everyone) will be held by the Georgia Postal History Society and the American First Day Cover Society
